INFORMATION SHEET FOR NEW MEMBERS

The Annual Membership Fee for TRLGA is \$35.00 (January - December) If you join TRLGA after July 1 our membership fee is \$20.00.

The above membership fee does not include your USGA GHIN handicap INDEX issued through AZ Golf. We require that your Index t be held through TRLGA. If you currently have an AZ GHIN from another club, and you want, we can transfer your GHIN from your old club. If you do NOT, you must have an AZ GHIN # issued. Go online to www. azgolf.org /become-a-member complete a profile and pay your dues on line.

Individual Membership Rates for AZ Golf membership

- 1. The date membership begins is the date a membership number is assigned.
- 2. Annual dues for club members shall be as follows: Fees paid between October 1 and December 31, 2018 will be \$30 and will cover membership for the following calendar year (2019).

Fees paid between January 1 and June 30, 2019 will be \$35 and will cover membership for the 2019 calendar year.

Fees paid between July I and September 30, 2019 will be \$20 and will cover membership for the balance of the current calendar year.

- 3. Any member giving up her membership at one club and transferring it to another club during the year shall not be charged an additional membership fee provided the AZ GOLF office has been notified of each transfer.
- 4. **IMPORTANT:** In fall of 2018 AWGA and AZ GOLF merged their records into one file. Some members had a shared email address with a spouse/family member. Each individual member must have their own email address

<u>Membership IN TRLGA Includes:</u> Individual and Team Play Days. The opportunity to play in Club Tournaments including: Club Championship, Match Play, Solheim Cup, No-frills tournaments, Cancer Tournament and Chili Pepper Tournament - Member Guest Day. You will be given reduced green fees on league play days. Fun social events, plus much more.

League Days:

League play day is Monday at Canoa Ranch and Wednesday at Torres Blancas.

League play times are posted on the website. Signup sheets are in the back members' room at Torres. Call the Pro Shop and the on-duty desk person will be able to sign you up. You need to call by Saturday at 1:00 PM. for Monday at the Ranch (520- 625-5200 ext. 2) and Monday by 1 PM. for Wednesday at Torres (520-625-5200 ext 3).

If you are a member of Torres/Ranch Golf courses the cost to play on league day is \$3.00 to the Pro Shop. Any winnings, you have, will be posted to your account as a credit or given to you as cash once a month. If it is a credit you can spend this credit at either course's Pro shop.

If you are **NOT** a member of the course but are a member of TRLGA you will have to pay green fees (amount is reduced for you on league play days/time) plus \$3.00 to the Pro Shop on league days. Any winnings, you have, will be posted to your account as a credit, or given to you as cash once a month. If it a credit you can spend this credit at either course's Pro shop.

Hole-in-One:

There is a Hole-in-One Insurance fund that you currently can join for \$3.00. The Treasurer collects the fee each time a hole-in-one is paid out.

Only a Hole-in-One earned on a regular play day or during a TRLGA sponsored event will qualify.

The Hole-in-One fund will pay \$50.00 to a member who has a hole-in-one on a regular play day or a TRLGA sponsored event. The Hole-on-One Fund also will pay for one drink per person, on the date the hole-in-one was made, at the club restaurant, immediately following play that day. You must be a hole-in-one member to receive a drink. For the Cancer Tournament or Chili Pepper, only the \$50.00 to the member will be paid.

Southern District:

Yearly cost to join Southern District is \$10.00 and this allows you to play in the Southern District Tournaments throughout the year.

The league also runs two Southern District tournaments per year on a pre-chosen ladies' day. One is the Del Sud (2-day) and the other is the Telegraphy Tournament (1-day).

The State of AZ is divided into Northern, Central and Southern Districts. These tournaments are separate from the State run Tournaments but the State (AWGA) does post the District tournaments on their website www.awga.org.

New Members Orientation:

TRLGA offers a New Members Orientation session. During this session all aspects of the organization are explained in depth. Such as: Standing Rules, Local Rules, Annual calendar, Interclub, Two Club, Ringers and much more. You will receive an invitation to attend.
